Content

- Total Nitrogen (N) 9% (9% Ammoniacal Nitrogen)
- Available Phosphate (P_2O_5) 34%

Application & positioning

- Consult the label for the application on a specific crop.
- 1 – 3 qt/ac as a foliar spray or soil drench.
- Compatible with many agrochemicals.

Benefits of Rappid

- Source of energy for the plant – a high amount of energy in the plant results in a higher BRIX level.
- Rappid has a near-neutral pH of 6.0 –7.0
- Holds onto cation in the soil making them available to the crop.
- Polyphosphate is slowly hydrolysed to an orthophosphate – more P over a longer time.
- Lower application rates compared to conventional phosphate fertilisers, especially in low productivity soils.
- Encourages root growth.
- Unlocks phosphates retained in the soil.
- Can be applied with some herbicides due to its near-neutral pH.
- Has the ability to move through the soil profile.
- Safe to use as foliar nutrition and does not cause phytotoxicity.
